

# Last Chance Audubon Society (LCAS) \$1000 Scholarship Application, Selection Process and Schedule 2021 – 2022 Academic Year

1. LCAS application, selection process and schedule are posted on the LCAS website (<https://www.lastchanceaudubon.org/learning/scholarship/>) and are also available from High School contacts:

2. Students should download the application form, complete their applications, and email to [scholarship@lastchanceaudubon.org](mailto:scholarship@lastchanceaudubon.org) with a teacher's letter of recommendation. (Teacher's letters can be emailed separately if preferred.)

3. Applications are due no later than April 15, 2022 to allow enough time for college admission notifications/decisions.

4. LCAS's three-member selection committee will review the applications, rank applicants individually, and will then reach committee consensus on awards by the end of April. Up to two awards will be made each year.

5. LCAS selection committee will make selection(s) by April 30th and notify the LCAS Board.

6. All students will be notified of the Board decision including those students not receiving an award.

7. LCAS will issue a press release. Students are reminded to notify their schools to publicize the LCAS award(s) at school commencement (s).

8. Checks will be sent or presented to students in early-mid August upon proof of college/university registration
